HomeCU Client Base Grows 14% in 4th Quarter 2003

BOISE, ID (April 23rd, 2004) – Database Management Services, Inc., announced today that approximately 30 credit unions contracted for the company's HomeCU Internet home banking service in the 4th quarter of 2003. In all, HomeCU added 64 credit unions to its roster in 2003, raising the total number of HomeCU institutions to 250.
